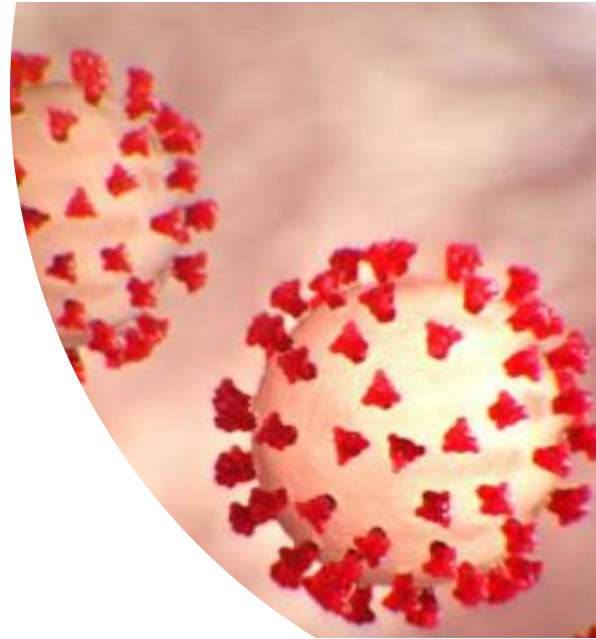

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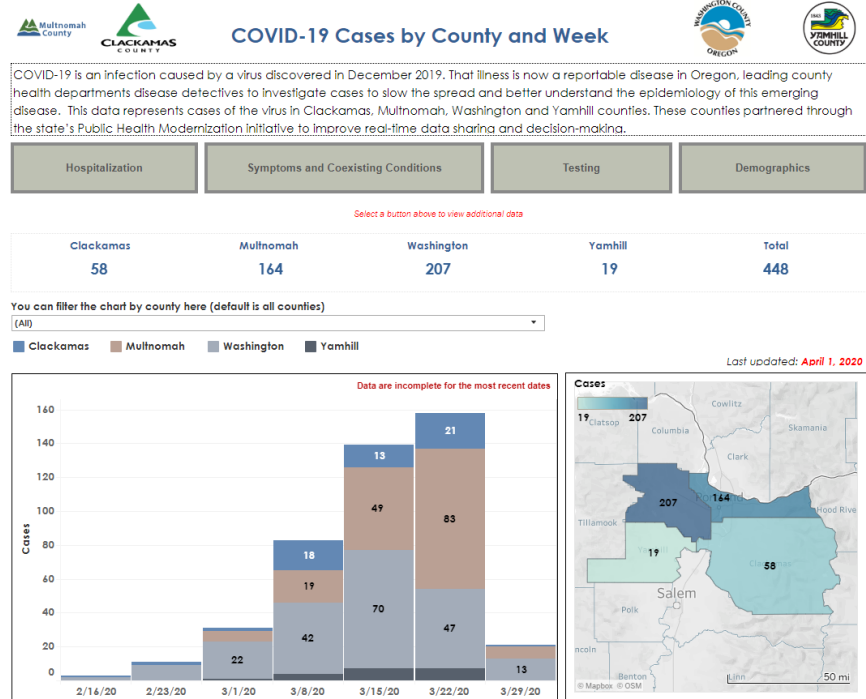

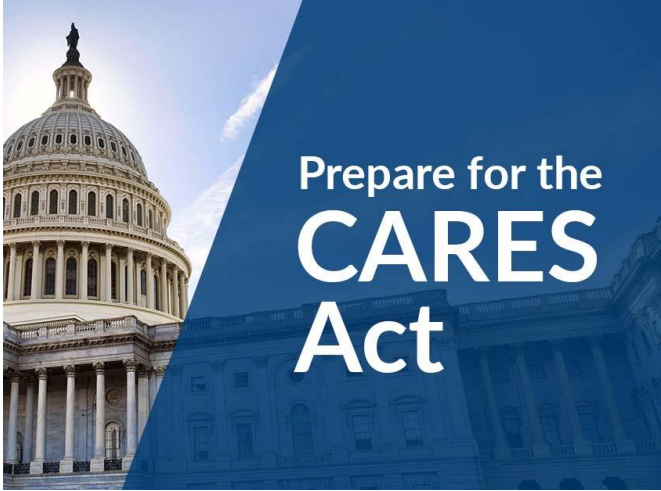


# Commerical Rent Moratorium

- April 1, 2020
- Gov. Kate Brown issues 90-day moratorium on commercial evictions
- Prevents landlords of commercial properties from terminating any tenant’s lease or taking any action relating to evictions or otherwise interfering with a “tenant’s right to possession of the leased premises.”
- Within 30 days of missing rent - Required to provide:
  - “documentation or other evidence that nonpayment is caused by, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, the COVID-19 pandemic”
  - evidence of “loss of income due to any governmental restrictions.”
- Tenants are expected to:
  - notify landlords “as soon as reasonably possible” that they will be unable to pay rent in full
  - make partial payments to the extent they are financially able.
- Late charges and other penalties are waived during the moratorium.
